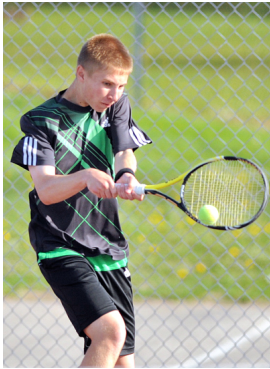


Warriors clip Cougars in boys tennis
