The third quarter was the Holmes and Botkin show as they scored all of Kennedy's 15 points.

"We were trying to execute as many options of our offense as we could with each possession and I got some really good shots," said Holmes who put in nine of her points in the third quarter. "We were really trying to use this game to prepare for Wednesday."

"I basically took advantage of what our offense gives me inside and I was able to finish," said Botkin. "Michalyn (Mohr) is a really good player so it wasn't easy for me on the inside."

Marion (13-8) was led in scoring by Michalyn Mohr with 12 points and Amanda Sahm with 11.

The Indians played without starting guard Micaela Combs who was nursing a leg injury. She will be ready to go Wednesday when Marion begins play in the first round of tournament action.
