

Hadzic named to IHSSCA Hall of Fame

Amir Hadzic, head coach of the Xavier boys soccer program, has been selected for induction into the Iowa High School Soccer Coaches Association (IHSSCA) Hall of Fame.

The induction ceremony will be held Feb. 20 at the Jacobsen Building on the Iowa State Fairgrounds in Des Moines.

Hadzic has served as head coach at Xavier since 2007 and has led the Saints to the 2010, 2011 and 2013 Iowa Class 2A state championships.

Hadzic's career record as a high school soccer coach is 154-87-3 (107-45-2 at Xavier; 47-42-1 at Prairie). He is a five-time Metro Coach of the Year and the 2010 and 2011 Mississippi Valley Conference Coach of the Year.

"We are excited that Coach Hadzic has been selected for induction into the Soccer Coaches Hall of Fame," said Mike Winker, Xavier Activities Director. "This is a well-deserved honor for a man who is a true winner in every capacity, is a first-class role model for our students and an excellent representative of Xavier High School. The entire Xavier community is proud of Coach Hadzic."

In addition to his head coaching duties at Xavier, Hadzic is the head men's soccer coach at Mount Mercy University.
