

Cougars claim Xavier quad

Quinn Jamrok shot a 34 Monday at Twin Pines to lead Kennedy to a one-stroke win at the Xavier boys golf quadrangular meet.

Kennedy finished at 142. Xavier and Waterloo West were at 143 and Cedar Falls 152.

Xavier was awarded second place on the basis of its fifth golfer - Colin Gunn - shooting a 38. West's fifth golfer shot a 40.

Jamrok and West's Austin Jackson tied for medalist honors at 2-under par.

Kennedy's other three golfers - Harrison Moore, Davis Sutton and Landon Crippes - shot par 36s.

Matt Junge and Robbie Thinnes led Xavier with 1-under 35s.
