

DMAcc snaps Eagles' streak at 18

BOONE - DMAcc built an 11-point halftime lead and went on to hand No.2 Kirkwood its first conference loss of the season Saturday in an Iowa Community College Athletic Conference women's basketball game.

The loss snapped Kirkwood's winning streak at 18 games in its regular-season finale.

Kirkwood (26-4, 15-1) was led by Kianna Jacobs' 14 points. Alexis Fitzpatrick scored 11. Jacobs also grabbed eight rebounds and had four assists.

The Eagles played without starter Bianca Dufelmeier, who was injured in practice on Thursday.

DMAcc (23-7, 12-4) avenged a seven-point loss at Kirkwood on Jan. 31.

Kirkwood hosts Ellsworth in a first-round regional tournament game Tuesday at 5:30 p.m. at Johnson Hall.
