Rima reaches 600 wins as Kirkwood sweeps

AUBURNDALE, Fla. - Todd Rima joined the 600 victory club on Friday when the Kirkwood Eagles swept a doubleheader from Sussex County, 11-1 and 4-3, on their abbreviated spring trip to Florida.

Rima has a 601-381 record in 19 years as a head college baseball coach, including a 236-134 mark in eight years at Kirkwood. He also served as the head coach at NIACC for 11 years.

Kirkwood has suspended all of its spring sports through April 3 due to precautions regarding the corona virus.

Joel Vaske and Kyle Moeder hit home runs for the Eagles in the 11-1 victory in the opener, which ended after five innings due to the mercy rule. Vaske was 4-for-4 and drove in five runs.



Rian Yates (2-1) pitched four strong innings for the victory in Game 1. He allowed one run in four innings, with four strikeouts.

Vaske belted another home run and scored twice in the 4-3 victory in Game 2. Patterson had two RBIs.

Starting pitcher Luke Llewellyn was touched for one unearned run in 4 2/3 innings, but left with no decision. Clayton Nettleton picked up the victory in relief by striking out the side in the top of the seventh. Kirkwood won the game in the bottom of the seventh in walk-off style.
