# Carter belts $\mathbf{2}$ homers for KCC 

ARKANSAS CITY, Kan. - Randyn Carter belted a pair of home runs for the fourth-ranked Kirkwood Eagles Monday in Kansas.

One of Carter's homers came in a 3-2 loss to 19th-ranked Cowley County. The other homer came in an 18-6 romp over Cowley in the second game of their doubleheader.

The split left Kirkwood with a 13-4 record for the season.

Taleah Smith, Stewart, Lauren Klaahsen, Jayme Finn and Shelby Hulsebus drove in two runs. Autum Barthelman scored four runs. Carter scored three times. Kuch, Jackson and Stewart scored twice.

Jackson, Stewart and Klaahsen joined Carter in the home-run parade in Game 2. Stewart collected two doubles.

Bradee Bouman was the beneficiary of all that offense and cruised to the victory after Kirkwood built a 17-1 lead in the top of the fourth.
