Post player Ariel Sneed chipped in with 14 points and nine rebounds for Kirkwood (3-0) and Tyra Polite knocked in 12 points coming off the bench.

"I felt like I was struggling all night on offense," said Sneed. "I just need to continue to make adjustments to my game and keep improving."

Kirkwood dominated the boards by out-rebounding Joliet, 51-30. Cassidy Clark led the Eagles with 10 rebounds.
