Kathryn Vander Poel of Mount Mercy claimed the women's 1,000 meter run (3:00.98) in a tight race with teammate Andrea Ertz, who finished second in 3:01.13.

The Mustangs also received second-place showings from Angela Willoughby in the 55 meter dash (7.76), Rachel Gadient in the 55 hurdles (9.29) and Jasmine Wardell in the shot put (11.62 meters). Vanessa Cortes was third in the 3000 meter run (10:46.97).

The Mount Mercy men tied for fourth in the team standings and the women finished fifth out of seven teams.
