The lowa Women's Softball League will run through Sunday, July 30 with doubleheaders each Sunday at Kirkwood and Coe. We use a continuous batting order with free defensive substitution to make the playing time as equal as possible for everyone.

The league features players from NCAA schools (D-I, D-II and D-III) along with players from NAIA schools and junior colleges. Now they'll get a rare chance to play on TV.

A voluntary \$5 gate fee is collected between doubleheaders, but all students and senior citizens are admitted free of charge.
