Players can choose their division on the registration form.

We will play a 16-game season in 2018 with a series of eight doubleheaders. The dates are June 3-10-17-24 and July 8-15-22-29. We will not play during the first week of July due to the holiday.

The player fee is \$100 and may be paid by using PayPal when registering. Each player will get 16 games, a team jersey and a league T-shirt.

Please help us inform players about the league. Scholarships are available. All anyone has to do is ask. There is no paperwork.

We encourage players to enroll now and reserve a place in the league. We will give a full \$100 refund to anyone who registers and then is unable to play due to injury, travel, summer job or any other reason, with no questions asked.

It's better to enroll as soon as possible and save a spot in the program, rather than waiting too long and possibly missing a chance to play because all the spots are filled. We plan to have 14 players per team with a total of 140 players in the program.

Graduating seniors are eligible for the league, even though they will have finished their college eligibility by next June. Former college players are eligible as well, by invitation only.

We used a continuous batting order and free defensive substitution this season and it worked very well, ensuring that everyone had equal playing time. We also had a time limit on games to

We had players from 25 different colleges in the program this year with a nice mixture of NCAA D1, NCAA D2, NCAA D3, NAIA and junior colleges.
